When you do experiments with fire...

Wear cotton clothing. No synthetic wind pants, soccer shorts, nylons, tights.

Avoid loose clothing like long, loose sleeves and loose shirttails.

Tie back loose hair.

Make sure a fire extinguisher is close. Know how to use it.

Make sure spray bottles are close. Keep them filled with water.

Wear safety goggles when burning paper or wildland fuels.

Extinguish burned material with water spray before putting it into the trash.

Fire is not out until there is no smoke or heat.

If a fire starts on you, stop, drop, and roll.

Do not do these experiments at home or in wildlands.
